
Player and Spectator Code of Conduct

Centres

- Customers must follow the directions of staff and adhere to Centre Conditions of Entry.
- Player or Spectator Code of Conduct breach will be referred to management, who may take action including suspension or removal from the competition.
- Physical violence, including the threat of such towards staff, players, spectators or otherwise is not accepted. Any person in breach of this may be removed.
- Verbal abuse or foul language towards staff, players, spectators or otherwise is not accepted. Any person in breach of this may be removed.
- Referees may remove any player, spectator or otherwise for abuse and/or for rough play for any period deemed necessary.
- Players and spectators should accept the referees' decision as final. Persistent argument with the referee will be considered verbal abuse.
- Where a difference between federation rules and our competition rules occurs, our competition rules shall take precedence.
- Any player identified as being affected by drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to play. A second offence will result in removal from the competition.
- Please respect the rights of every individual regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Appropriate footwear, clothing and protective equipment is a requirement for participation. Nails must be taped or cut, jewellery to be removed and no chewing gum is permitted.
- Players waiting for their game, as well as spectators, should remain in the foyer until the previous game has finished or remain in the seated area off the courts.
- Ball games and other play is not permitted in the foyer or corridor areas.
