



Guidelines for Running Competitions

2024 Central Coast Seniors Festival Expo Competition Terms and Conditions

The 2024 Central Coast Seniors Festival Expo Competition is open to residents aged 50+ from across the Central Coast. With \$300 in prizes on offer, this unique opportunity encourages seniors to engage with various exhibitors and activities throughout the expo while promoting well-being across different aspects of life.

To enter the competition, seniors must obtain stamps in each of the five (5) sections of their passport: Housing/Home Care, Social, Education, and Recreation, Transport, Health and Finance. By exploring the diverse range of exhibitors and services available, participants can enrich their understanding of resources tailored to their needs and interests. Entry is only valid on 21 March 2024 at the Central Coast Seniors Expo.

Completing the passport not only qualifies individuals for entry into the prize draw but also fosters meaningful interactions and connections within the community. From learning about housing options to discovering new recreational activities, the expo provides a holistic approach to senior well-being.

With prizes valued up to \$300, seniors have a fantastic incentive to fully immerse themselves in the expo experience. Prizes will include tangible items such as food hampers, personal care hampers, and gardening hampers as per the *Community Gaming Act 2018* and *Community Gaming Regulation 2020*.

All information on how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

This competition is run by Central Coast Council ('Council') ABN: 47 054 613 735.

The Council reserves the right at any time to disqualify any individual who the Council reasonably believes has breached any of the terms and conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper conduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition or the reputation of the Council.

Privacy Notification:

Some of the information that you are asked to provide on this form is personal information, such as your name and contact information. This information is being collected for the purpose of identification; judgement; communication in relation to; and promotion of this entry in the 2024 Central Coast Seniors Festival Expo Passport Competition ('Competition').

The information will be accessible by Council staff, and other third parties who form part of the judging panel for the Competition. It is voluntary to provide personal information on this form, however if the information is not provided, Council will not accept the entry in the

Competition. Applications to access or amend the personal information provided on this form may be made to Central Coast Council.

Eligibility:

1. Entry is open to:
 - Residents from across the Central Coast Council LGA aged 50 years and over.
 - Entrants must be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident of Australia.
 - The Competition is open to attendees of the 2024 Central Coast Seniors Festival Expo held on 21 March 2024 at Wyong Racecourse.
2. Employees of Council and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the Competition.
3. Entry to the competition is free.

How to enter the Competition:

4. The 2024 Central Coast Seniors Festival Expo Competition opens on 21 March 2024 and closes on 21 March 2024.
5. The 2024 Seniors Festival Expo Competition passport entries can be submitted:
 - In person at Central Coast Council stall, located at the Seniors Festival Expo, Wyong Racecourse, Wyong NSW 2259.
6. All Entries must be delivered to Central Coast Council stall, on Monday, 21 March 2024 entries must be submitted between 9am and 12pm.
7. Council does not accept any responsibility for any late or lost entries, or any other entries not properly received.
8. Council has absolute discretion; and reserves all rights; to verify the validity of all entries to the Seniors Festival Expo Competition, and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the entry process or who submits an entry that is deemed to not be in accordance with these terms and conditions.
9. Council will not be liable for any damages or loss suffered as a result of entry to the Seniors Festival Expo Competition.
10. Each entrant releases, and hereby indemnifies to the full extent permitted by law, Council, its employees, agents and assigns, from any and all liability which may arise from and/or all claims in connection with their entry, participation or the prize in the Seniors Festival Expo Competition.

11. Council may cancel or vary the Competition at any time. Council will not be responsible for any loss or costs incurred by the entrant or businesses in relation to such cancellation or variation.

Entry requirements:

12. Entrants must have at least one stamp in each section of the provided passport, which includes: 1) Housing/Home Care, 2) Social, Education, and Recreation, 3) Transport, 4) Health, and 5) Finance.
 - Incomplete entries will be disqualified.
13. All entrants must complete their details accurately and legibly on the entry form provided.
 - Incomplete or illegible entries will be disqualified.
14. Entries must be submitted to the designated entry box located at the Central Coast Council stall by 12:00 PM on 21 March 2024.
 - Each entrant can only submit a maximum of one (1) entry to the 2024 Seniors Festival Expo Competition.
 - Entries submitted after the specified deadline will not be considered.

Photographs, video footage and licences:

15. Each winner drawn consents to Council taking photographs and/or video footage of the entrant for the purpose of the Seniors Festival Expo.
16. Each entrant consents, and provides an irrevocable licence, to Council using and publishing, at its discretion, their entry, including the name, and age of the entrant; and any photographs and/or video footage of the entrant for the purpose of the Seniors Festival Expo, including but not limited to:
 - a. Promotion of the Seniors Festival Expo in the media, both print and online;
 - b. Display and promotion at any event associated with the Seniors Festival Expo Seniors Festival Expo Competition; and
 - c. Other non-commercial activities related to the functions of Council.
17. On all the above occasions, Council will credit the entrant.
18. Each entrant agrees that Council will not provide any financial compensation, in relation to any use of their entry or any photographs or video footage of the entrant.
19. Each entrant declares that he/she will not seek now or at any future time any financial compensation from Council in relation to any use of this entry or any photographs or video footage of the entrant.

Prize Draw

- 20. Prize drawing of the Seniors Festival Expo Competition will be conducted by a Council staff member on Thursday 21 March 2024 at 12.05pm.
- 21. Winners will be selected at random from all eligible entries received.
- 22. The decision of the Prize Draw is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection of winners and binding upon every entrant who enters the Competition. No correspondence regarding any decision will be entered into.

Awarding winners:

- 23. The winners of the Seniors Festival Expo Competition as determined by the Prize Draw will be announced at the Seniors Festival Expo on Thursday, 21 March 2024. Winner's names may be published on Council's website.

- 28. The prizes are non-transferable and not exchangeable. Prizes cannot be transferred or on-sold at a premium, offered as a prize or inducement, packaged or otherwise used for

advertising, promotional or other commercial purposes. (if tickets) The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to the bearer of any prize sold or otherwise provided or distributed in breach of this condition.

Complaints:

29. If Council receives a complaint from a person/s featured in an entry, or a complaint about the entry, Council may reject / remove the entry from the competition at its absolute discretion. No correspondence will be entered into in relation to any decision of Council in relation to the Seniors Festival Expo Competition.
