

Foyer Gallery Exhibition Proposal Guide

The Foyer Gallery

Located within the Gosford Regional Gallery, the Foyer Gallery is an exhibition space for emerging and established regional and national artists. It has 26 linear metres / 200 m² of exhibition space. Exhibitions generally run for four to five weeks and they are curated and installed by gallery staff. A panel of Gosford Regional Gallery staff reviews Foyer Gallery proposals twice a year to consider the following aspects of each proposal:

Technique: The level of technical skill demonstrated by the artist

Concept: Is the exhibition coherently united by an interesting / innovative concept?

Diversity: Does the exhibition contribute to the diversity of our exhibition program?

Interest: Will the exhibition appeal to a range of visitors / will it bring new visitors

to the Gallery?

Presentation: Will the artworks be presented in a professional manner?

Application Deadlines

1 November 2018 deadline for November assessment (exhibition proposals for 2020)

6 April 2019 deadline for April assessment (exhibition proposals for 2020/2021)

1 November 2019 deadline for November assessment (exhibition proposals for 2021)

Your proposal should include:

- Completed Foyer Gallery Proposal Cover Sheet. Please see form below.
- Exhibition proposal. This should include:
 - a. Explanation of the theme or premise of the exhibition.
 - b. Why is this exhibition relevant to the Gosford Regional Gallery program? (see general information about Gosford Regional Gallery below)
 - c. List of works, including: Artist, Title, Date, Medium, Dimensions for each work. If a complete list of works is not known, please provide a description of the anticipated number, medium and size of works.
 - d. Description of any special requirements including equipment, handling requirements, installation materials and costs.
- CV and artist's statement for each artist and curator involved in the exhibition
- Images of the artist(s) work and an image list.

Gosford Regional Gallery Background

Gosford Regional Gallery is located on the shores of Caroline Bay in East Gosford. It is part of a complex that also includes the Gosford/Edogawa Commemorative Garden, the Arts Centre, Gallery Shop and the Point Café Japanese Gardens. The Gallery was officially opened in April 2000 and is visited by approximately 170,000 people each year. Although the Gallery does not have a permanent collection, a diverse and stimulating exhibition program is maintained, consisting of a range of local, national and international exhibitions of various media including painting, photography, sculpture, textiles, ceramics, and works on paper. The Gallery has quickly become an important cultural, tourism and educational resource for the Central Coast community.

• **Governance** - To ensure the Gallery operates in a safe manner, with effective


