Who can apply?

The Lakes Festival EOI's are available to eligible businesses, companies or organisations that propose an event or event concept that satisfies the requirements. The festival committee is also looking to fund a range of unique events that provide the community and visitors with a diverse calendar of events from sporting events to arts, cultural and community events.

Type of Events

Events are assessed by the committee on their potential to involve the local community and attract visitors from outside the region. We are looking for bold, innovative and out of the box ideas, while still staying true to the theme of our waterways.

Events need to;

- Facilitate a vibrant and innovative events culture within the Central Coast.
- Encourage the development of tourism in the Central Coast and increase economic development opportunities.
- Encourage the involvement of local residents in events and Festivals that can facilitate positive interaction, cultural activity and a strong community identity among the citizens of our diverse community.

- Lanterns on the Lake / Light Festival
- Sailing Regatta
- Series of Cinema under the stars
- Art Events
- Installations including Floating Water Sculptures
