Draft Land Transaction Policy

In accordance with the Resolution of Council on 13 July 2020, the draft Land Transaction Policy has been placed on public exhibition for 28 days to allow for public consultation prior to being finalised and adopted.

The consolidated policy provides a framework for Council which will inform decision and directions regarding Council's property portfolio in a consistent manner across the Local Government Area and in accordance with relevant legislation.

This draft policy is a consolidation of the former Gosford City Council's Land and Property Transactions Policy and Wyong Shire Council's Property Transactions – Sales and Acquisitions with other policies informing its development.

The policy will provide contemporary, clear and consistent guidelines for Council's management of land transactions across the whole region.
