# **Central Coast Series Skate and Scooter Online Competition** 2022 - 2023

## **Terms and Conditions**

#### **Central Coast Series Skate and Scooter Online Competition**

All information on how to enter this competition forms part of these terms and conditions. Entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

This competition is run by Central Coast Council ('Council') ABN: 47 054 613 735 of 2 Hely Street, Wyong NSW 2259.

The Council reserves the right at any time to disqualify any individual who the Council reasonably believes has breached any of the terms and conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper conduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the competition or the reputation of the Council.

### **Privacy Notification:**

Some of the information that you are asked to provide on this form is personal information, such as your name and contact information. This information is being collected for the purpose of identification; judgement; communication in relation to; and promotion of this entry in Central Coast Series Skate and Scooter Competition. (Central Coast Series Competition)

The information will be accessible by Council staff, and other third parties who form part of the judging panel for the Competition. It is voluntary to provide personal information on this form, however if the information is not provided, Council will not accept the entry in the Competition. Applications to access or amend the personal information provided on this form may be made to Central Coast Council.

#### **Eligibility:**

- 1. Entry to the skate street, skate park and scooter competition is open to:
  - Age 5 to 24 years
  - Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia
  - Competitors must reside in the Central Coast Local Government Area
  - Amateurs and sponsored riders. Sponsored riders must only compete in the sponsored riders division.
- 2. Employees of Council and their immediate families are eligible to enter the Competition where there is independence in judging eg independent panel member.

- 3. Entrants under the age of 18 must have the consent of their parent or legal guardian to enter. Entrants under the age of 18 are required to provide proof of consent from a parent or legal guardian by attaching the under 18 consent form (Attachment 1) or by completing the consent question on the registration form.
- 4. Entry to the competition is free.

#### **How to enter the Competition:**

- 5. The Central Coast Series Competition registration opens on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2022 at 9.00am and closes on 29<sup>th</sup> January 2023 at 5.00pm.
- 6. Registration can be submitted:
  - Online (registration link TBC once approved)

7. All registrations must be received within the competition period as outlined above.

- 8. Council does not accept any responsibility for any late or lost entries, or any other entries not properly received.
- Council has absolute discretion; and reserves all rights; to verify the validity of all entries
  to the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition, and to disqualify any entrant who tampers with
  the entry process or who submits an entry that is deemed to not be in accordance with
  these terms and conditions.
- 10. Council will not be liable for any damages or loss suffered as a result of entry to the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition.
- 11. Each entrant releases, and hereby indemnifies to the full extent permitted by law, Council, its employees, agents and assigns, from any and all liability which may arise from and/or all claims in connection with their entry, participation or the prize in the <a href="Central Coast Series">Central Coast Series</a> Competition.
- 12. Council may cancel or vary the Competition at any time. Council will not be responsible for any loss or costs incurred by the entrant or businesses in relation to such cancellation or variation.

#### **Entry requirements:**

- 13. All entrants must complete the registration form and if under 18 must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- 14. Each participant must wear a fastened safety helmet to compete. Any participant that does not wear a fastened helmet will be disqualified.

#### Photographs, video footage and licences:

- 15. Each entrant consents to Council taking photographs and/or video footage of the entrant for the purpose of the Central Coast Series\_Competition.
- 16. Each entrant consents, and provides an irrevocable licence, to Council using and publishing, at its discretion, their entry, including the name, and age of the entrant; and any photographs and/or video footage of the entrant for the purpose of the\_Central Coast Series Competition, including but not limited to:
  - a. Uploading of the photos, videos and the name of the entrant on the <u>Central Coast Series Competition</u> website: <u>www.centralcoast.nsw.gov.au</u>, and social media platforms.
  - b. Promotion of the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition in the media, both print and online;
  - c. Display and promotion at any event associated with the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition; and
  - d. Other non-commercial activities related to the functions of Council.
- 17. Please limit the promotion of individual businesses as a core part of the entry. Any use or reference to private businesses will in no way imply or be perceived to imply products or services from that business are superior or favoured by Council.
- 18. Each entrant agrees that Council will not provide any financial compensation, in relation to any use of their entry or any photographs or video footage of the entrant.
- 19. Each entrant declares that he/she will not seek now or at any future time any financial compensation from Council in relation to any use of this entry or any photographs or video footage of the entrant.

### **Judging of the Competition:**

- 20. Judging of the <u>Central Coast Series</u> will be conducted by a panel comprised of 3 independent persons selected on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023
- 21. Judging will be anonymous and based on a points system. The criteria against which entries will be judged, will include, but not be limited to:
  - Number of tricks performed
  - Skill level of tricks performed
- 22. The decisions of the judging panel in relation to any aspect of the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition will be final and binding upon every entrant who enters the Competition. No correspondence regarding any decision of the judging panel will be entered into.

### **Awarding winners:**

23. The winners of the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition as determined by the judging panel and will be determined on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

Winners names may be published on Council's website and Central Coast Series Facebook and Instagram accounts.

24. The <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition prizes are:

For each age division in each discipline overall competition winners

1st Place - Gift or voucher to the Value of \$100, Trophy / Medallion and Winners T-Shirt

Runner Up - Gift or voucher to the Value of \$75, Trophy / Medallion and Runner Up T-Shirt

Council makes no warranty or representation as to the condition and suitability for use of the prize.

- 25. Acceptance of any prize in the <u>Central Coast Series</u> Competition is conditional on signing of Council's release form (Attachment 2).
- 26. If the prize remains unclaimed for two months from the time notice is given, Council will have the right to determine another winner or not.
- 27. The prizes are non-transferable and not exchangeable.

#### **Complaints:**

28. If Council receives a complaint from a person/s featured in an entry, or a complaint about the entry, Council may reject / remove the entry from the competition at its absolute discretion.
