The Harvest Festival was developed to link with local farmers, businesses and events based in the mountains and valleys of the Central Coast – Calga, Somersby, Mangrove Mountain, Peats Ridge, Kulnura, Yarramalong, Dooralong and Jilliby.

The Festival was developed with a unique brand and image that will become a consistent, recognisable and sustainable event in its own right, whilst highlighting the region to increase tourism to the area.

OBJECTIVES & OUTCOMES


- From the outset Council recognised we could not practically deliver nor fund a program of events of this scale ourselves and instead focussed on developing an innovative event model built around community partnerships and ownership.
- The festival delivers a combination of community partnership events and commercial events to provide a diverse festival calendar.
- The festival program was designed to encourage attendees to follow an event trail encouraging visitation at multiple local farms and food hubs, family activities and event hubs.

2018 SURVEY RESULTS

98% attendees were satisfied with the event.

29% of respondents were from out of region.

2% of respondents were from interstate or from overseas.

69% of attendees visited one or more event hubs throughout the region.

11% of visitors stayed overnight in the region.

65% were first timers at Harvest Festival 2018.

Overall attendees suggested they will be returning again next year.

Increase in yearly regional visitation with 15% of attendees have returned to the area since Harvest Festival 2017.



TOURISM

For the second year of the event the statistics show a high level of interest from out of region visitation to the local farming properties. Identified areas were Newcastle, Lake Macquarie, Central Coast, Hornsby, North Shore, The Hills District and Western Suburbs of Sydney.



MARKETING

Central Coast Council will market the festival in its entirety and utilise postcode data, demographic information and historical marketing information to assist in the development of a targeted marketing campaign to promote Harvest Festival to the Coast and out of region areas.

The primary geographic focus is on the Central Coast with a secondary focus on Newcastle, Lake Macquarie, Hornsby, The Hills District, North Shore, Inner and Western Suburbs of Sydney.

We will also focus on Wollongong, South Coast and Canberra regions, as well as our northern neighbours.

- Events are assessed on their potential to involve the local and larger communities at each event.
- Events must incorporate the land/local produce or farming by their location or theme.

 Preference will be given to events that have the ability to attract attendees from outside the region and or promote local produce /

producers.

- Long lunch with local produce
- Obstacle course races / fun runs

Council will support the overall event logistics of the festival which includes all approvals from external and internal stakeholders.

- We will be able to support and market the entire festival program through its extensive media networks.

- A dedicated Events Officer will oversee Council's Events Strategy and the implementation of our Events Support Processes.
- Conduct extensive traffic management and control plans for the region.
- Maintenance of Council amenities buildings, toilets, road reserves and parks during the festival.
- Secure ongoing festival sponsorship to maintain a sustainable approach for future years.
