Running since 2003, EMERGING is a biennial art award to support emerging practices and provides the opportunity to develop and exhibit a new or existing body of work at Gosford Regional Gallery, this includes supporting installation based practices and non-traditional mediums.

Chosen works will be exhibited at Gosford Regional Gallery from 4 February 2023 – 26 March 2023.

Accepted submissions will receive \$1000 for the development of new work or presentation of existing work, with one submission being awarded a \$5,000 Emerging Prize, announced at the exhibition opening on the 3 March 2022.

Submissions for EMERGING 2023 must be lodged with Gosford Regional Gallery by 1 November 2022.

- A title
- Concept (up to 500 words)
- Physical description including installation requirements and installation timeframe (up to 250 words)
- Supporting material: up to ten clearly labelled image or media files
- Curriculum vitae: including art education and exhibition history
- · Instagram handle and/or website

Submission Assessment Criteria

- Concept: the proposal is conceptually strong and the body of work is cohesive
- Technique: the proposal demonstrates the artist's technical proficiency
- Presentation: the proposal addresses how the Gallery space will be utilised and demonstrates a considered installation process.

Installation and Perametres of Work

Selected submissions will each be assigned a space within Gosford Regional Gallery at the curator's discretion of up to 20 metres of wall space or 70 square metres of floor space (or a specified combination of both). The Gallery has a ceiling height of four metres.

Any special requirements regarding space should be addressed in the physical description section of the submission.

Artists will be responsible for the transport of work to and from the Gallery and will not be provided with an extensive production budget for the realisation of the concept.

Sale

All works exhibited can be for sale. Selected finalists will need to provide prices for any work available for sale. Gosford Regional Gallery will manage the sales of the artwork during exhibition period and charge a 35% commission (including GST on commission).
