Library Book Club membership

Introduction

The purpose of this guideline is to outline the circumstances and conditions of Central Coast Library Service Book Club Membership.

Purpose

Council maintains library services for the Central Coast community. Our Book Clubs are a great way to discover new authors and exciting books. They foster stimulating conversation, debate, and encourage community connectedness. The Library's mission includes providing access to a wide range of information sources, including Book Club Sets.

Statement

The Library service provides access to over 100 Book Club Set titles for the exclusive use by registered Book Clubs ranging from latest releases, hot topics and literary classics.

Each registered Book Club requires a Co Ordinator

Book Club Coordinators are responsible for:

- Collection and payment of group membership fees

- Ensuring all members agree to the terms of use for Book Club Membership
- Bringing Book Club members together to make title selections for the following 12 months

Each Book Club should have a maximum of 10 members

Annual Book Club Membership entitles members to access up to 12 Book Club Sets per year (one book club set per month).

Membership payment is due by 31 August and can be made at any Council Customer Service point.

Nonpayment of Book Club Membership will lead to suspension of Book Club Membership and access to Book Club resources

Book Clubs can meet and utilise Book Club resources either in one of Central Coast Council's Library branches or in other locations outside of the library branches.

Book Club kits contain 10 regular print books, 2 large print books, one audio book, one eBook when possible, and discussion notes where possible.

Individual Book Club members will borrow Book Club items on their own card
