Introduction to Drawing

This class is suitable for all student levels, from beginners to advanced. Students will be able to work on their own projects and will receive individual instruction in all methods of watercolour, including pen and pastels.



Drawing with Colour

Every Thursday, 21 Feb – 14 Mar 12.30pm - 3.30pm

\$130/\$122.50 (members) for four weeks.

A comprehensive introduction to colour drawing mediums including: colour pencil, watercolour pencil, pastels and markers. Students will learn the major techniques, including: glazing (layering), laying strokes, and burnishing. Students will also learn tips and tricks for creating special effects and textures, and methods for working on coloured paper and unconventional surfaces. Information about materials and tools will also be provided.

AUSTRALIAN NATURE ART

\$80/\$75 (members) for four weeks.

This class is for kids with a passion for art and nature. Each week will feature a different Aussie animal or plant group, including: mammals, sea creatures, flowers, insects, dinosaurs and birds. Students will be introduced to a variety of mediums and to some fundamentals of art (e.g. composition, negative space, elements of design, etc.). They will also receive a bit of art history related to each weekly focus.

Suitable for ages 5—15.

If a class is cancelled, you will be notified by phone as early as possible prior to class commencement and a refund will be issued. Unruly behaviour by children in classes will not be tolerated. Management reserves the right to refuse enrolment should such circumstances arise. Refunds will not be given if a student discontinues a class that has begun, or if less than 48 hours cancellation notice is given. A \$15 administration fee will be applied to changes in enrolment.
