Adult Classes @ Gosford Regional Gallery

Watercolour with Anne Brack Mondays, 6 May - 1 July 9:00am - 12:00pm

8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) This class is suitable for all students, from beginners to advanced. Students will be able to work on their own projects and will receive individual instruction in all methods of watercolour, including pen and pastels.

Foundation Painting with Jon Ellis Mondays, 6 May – 1 Jul, 12:30pm – 3:30pm

8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) This structured course introduces students to the fundamentals necessary to becoming confident about tackling their own painting. It is the ideal foundation for anyone wanting to join Jon's morning class, "Develop Expression in your Painting."

Portrait Drawing Sessions: Long Poses Mondays, 6.30pm – 9:00pm, February to November. There is no class on the fifth Monday of the month, when this occurs. \$15 per week (pay on the night). This is a drop-in, untutored group which is ideal for those with some experience, wishing to improve their portrait techniques or work on one artwork to conclusion. Sessions are based on one pose for a four-week period, for students who wish to work on paintings, sculptures or more detailed studies, directly from life. New poses commence first Monday of each month.

Central Coast Botanical Art Group Tuesdays, 7 May – 2 Jul, 9:00am – 12:00pm

9 weeks: \$155/\$145 (members) This group aims to foster members' learning in the genre of botanical art through sharing, experimentation and discussion. The group has no regular tutor; however, members freely offer constructive advice to each other. New members are very welcome.

Nature Under Foot with Molly Gill Tuesdays, 7 May - 25 Jun, 12:30pm - 3:30pm

8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) This term the focus will be on the diversity, beauty, and textures of the forest floor: the mosses, leaf litter, mini beasts, lichens, rocks, tree roots, fungi, etc. that comprise the natural mosaic. Each session will feature a different medium and/or technique and botanical/natural element.

Develop Expression in your Painting with Jon Ellis Wednesdays, 8 May – 26 Jun, 10:00am – 3:00pm

8 weeks: \$360/\$345 (members) Through the guidance of Jon Ellis, students are encouraged to develop their own work and style in a supportive and non-judgemental group atmosphere.

The Artist's Studio with Cathryn McEwen Wednesdays, 8 May – 26 Jun, 6:00pm – 9:00pm

8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) Immerse yourself in a friendly environment where you'll be taken through a creative experience as you work on personal projects. Students will develop their own style under the expert guidance of respected artist and teacher, Cathryn McEwen. Beginners welcome.

Watercolours Art Group Thursdays, 9 May – 4 Jul, 9:00am – 12:00pm

9 weeks: \$155/\$145 (members) The Watercolours Art Group is a group of like-minded artists who meet on Thursday mornings in a friendly and supportive environment. The group has no tutor; however, members freely offer constructive advice to each other.

Approaches to Drawing (Beginners and Intermediate) with Cathryn McEwen Thursdays, 9 May – 27 Jun,

12:30pm – 3:30pm. 8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) Each week, those students new to drawing will be guided through a range of approaches "from perspective to expressive". The exploration of a variety of media and subjects (including portraiture) will provide a thorough introduction to this art form. Students who have had previous drawing experience can either choose to revise their skills with the weekly focus, or be guided through personal projects to further develop visual expression with specific media.



Life Drawing Sessions Thursdays, February – November, 6.30pm – 9:00pm, \$15 per week (pay on the night). This is a drop-in group which requires no booking. This class is ideal for those with some experience wishing to improve their technique and build a folio of drawings.

Pastels Art Group Fridays, 10 May – 5 Jul, 9:00am – 12:00pm

9 weeks: \$155/\$145 (members) The Pastels Art Group is a group of likeminded artists which meets on Friday mornings in a friendly and supportive environment. The group has no regular tutor; however, members freely offer constructive advice to each other. Those wishing to utilise other two-dimensional water-based media are also welcome to enrol.

The Artist's Studio with Cathryn McEwen, Fridays, 10 May – 28 Jun, 12:30pm – 3:30pm, 8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) Immerse yourself in a friendly environment where you'll be taken through a creative experience as you work on personal projects. Students will develop their own style under the expert guidance of respected artist and teacher, Cathryn McEwen. Beginners welcome.






Adult Classes @ The Entrance Gallery and Studio

Painters' Studio, with Cathryn McEwen Mondays, 6 May – 1 Jul, 9:00am – 12:00pm. 8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) A creative environment for beginners or students with previous painting experience, as we explore the challenges of painting. The class will include demonstrations on a variety of skills, media and approaches. Students will gain confidence in their own expression through personal projects. Materials list discussed with each student prior to start of term.

Introduction to Drawing with Molly Gill Mondays, 6 May – 1 Jul, 12:30pm – 3:30pm. 8 weeks: \$260/245 (members). A comprehensive and full-on introduction to pencil drawing covering all the bases, including: basic materials and optional tools/aids for drawing, line, tone/value, light and shadow, positive and negative space, composition, perspective, proportion, and creating special effects and textures on the 2-D surface. Watch your drawing improve over the course of the term!

Working with Watercolour, with Anne Brack Tuesdays, 7 May – 25 Jun, 1:00pm – 4:00pm. 8 weeks: \$260/ \$245 (members) This class is suitable for all student levels, from beginners to advanced. Students will be able to work on their own projects and will receive individual instruction in all projects and methods of watercolour including pen and pastels.

Drawing with Colour with Molly Gill Thursdays, 9 May – 27 Jun, 12:30pm – 3:30pm. 8 weeks: \$260/\$245 (members) A comprehensive introduction to colour drawing mediums including; colour pencil, watercolour pencil, pastels and markers. Students will learn the major techniques, including: glazing (layering), laying strokes, and burnishing. Students will also learn tips and tricks for creating special effects and textures, and methods for working on coloured paper and unconventional surfaces, Information about materials and tools will also be provided.

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Art Mechanics with Shelley McGavin Mondays, 6 May – 1 Jul, 4:00pm – 5:30pm. 8 weeks: \$165/\$155 (members) Ages 9 -15 INTERMEDIATE. Experience themed art activities, developed to extend student art skills and creative processes. Students will be guided with art fundamentals, using a variety of art materials and studio practices.

Emerging Art-itudes with Shelley McGavin Tuesdays, 7 May – 25 Jun, 4:00pm – 5:30pm. 8 weeks: \$165/\$155 (members) Ages 6-10 BEGINNER. A fun introduction to a range of art materials, techniques and styles. Students will explore the creative process through a mixture of playful observations and experiments that target the imagination. Best suited to beginner artists.

Technical with Shelley McGavin Wednesdays, 8 May –26 Jun, 4:00pm – 5:30pm. 8 weeks: \$165/\$155 (members). Ages 11 – 16 ADVANCED. For students who wish to develop their art techniques in drawing and painting. With a new theme each term, students will choose how they wish to develop a small body of work of two to three art pieces under the guidance of the instructor.

Australian Nature Art with Molly Gill Mondays, 6 May – 1 Jul, 4:00pm – 5:30pm. 8 weeks: \$165/\$155 (members). Ages 5 -15. This class is for kids with a passion for art and nature.
