POLICY OBJECTIVES

To control helicopter landings on open space areas.

POLICY STATEMENT

Helicopter landings on Council open space areas will not be considered with the exception in the event of an emergency, where emergency service operations will be permitted on Council sportsgrounds or within Kincumba Mountain Reserve.

Open Space

For the purpose of this Policy, 'Open Space' is defined as any community land and Council Controlled Crown Land reserves whether Council is the Crown Trust Manager or not used for structured or casual recreational activities. This open space includes mountains, bushlands, beaches, foreshores, estuaries, informal passive reserves and active recreation areas.
