Gosford Art Prize entry fee is \$30 per entry (max. 2 entries per artist)

Gosford Ceramics Prize entry fee is \$20 per entry (max. 2 entries per artist)

ARTWORK

- Work must not exceed two metres in any one direction and should be easily lifted by two people.
- Work must be presented ready for exhibition. The artist's name, address, telephone number, title of work and retail price (or not for sale "NFS") must be noted on the back (or bottom) of each work.
- All works must be dry.

ELIGIBILITY

The Prize is open to all artists, with the exception of employees of Central Coast Council.

All artwork must have been produced within the last 12 months.

To enter the Aboriginal art prize you must be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent, identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander and be accepted as such in the community in which you live.

EXHIBITION

A selection of entries will be included in the Gosford Art Prize exhibition from 14 September - 3 November 2019. All works selected for exhibition must remain on show for the full duration of the exhibition. The names of the finalists included in the exhibition will be posted on the Gosford Regional Gallery website on 9 September 2019.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The winners are determined by a judging panel appointed by the Gallery. All works are judged on merit and the judges' decision will be final. The Viewer's Choice Award is judged by votes cast by visitors to the exhibition.

In the event of a dispute arising regarding the rules and conditions of entry, a decision made by Gallery Management shall be final.

By entering the Gosford Art Prize you agree to grant Gosford Regional Gallery a non-exclusive licence to photograph your artwork and publish images of the artwork, or a detail of the artwork, for the purpose of documentation and the promotion of the Gosford Art Prize and/or Gosford Regional Gallery.

All works exhibited can be for sale. The price must be clearly marked on the entry form. The Gallery will take a 35% commission (inc. GST). Artists need to provide the retail (selling) price, including GST (if registered for GST). The Gallery is not able to offer advice on this. Sales will be paid approximately three weeks after the conclusion of the exhibition and receipt of paperwork.

Work on exhibition will be insured against fire, theft and vandalism. Gosford Regional Gallery will not be held liable for minor accidental damage that may occur to artwork during the storage or judging of the Art Prize or deterioration due to inherent vice.
