A meeting of the Council's Employment and Economic Development Committee (EEDC) was held on 20 January 2016. I <u>attach</u> the following:

The EEDC resolved as follows in respect to item "6.1 Temporary Economic Stimulus Plan":

- "1 That the Committee <u>receive and note</u> the report on the Temporary Economic Stimulus Plan (TESP).
- That the Committee <u>recommend</u> to Council, that the TESP scheme be extended for a further 3 years with a varied rate of contributions that matches the current contribution rates."

Council has not delegated its authority to the Committee to make decisions on its behalf. Accordingly the recommendation set out in respect to the Temporary Economic Stimulus Plan requires a separate resolution to the adoption of the minutes of the Committee.

The purposes of this Mayoral Minute are:

- 2. To seek a resolution of the Council to extend the operation of the Temporary Economic Stimulus Plan, in accordance with the recommendation of the EEDC.

- That Council <u>extend</u> the Temporary Economic Stimulus Package (TESP) scheme for a further 3 years with a varied rate of contributions that matches the current contribution rates, in accordance with the recommendation of the resolution of the Economic Development Committee Meeting held on 20 January 2016.

## Council staff note

Councillors have previously been briefed on the extension of the TESP. The Director, Property & Economic Development can provide the Council with further information on the effect and consequences of the extension to the TESP recommended by the EEDC.

# Consideration of s.23A guidelines

The Chief Executive of the NSW Office for Local Government has issued guidelines titled "Council Decision Making during Merger Proposal Periods" pursuant to s.23A(1) of the Local Government Act 1993 ("LG Act"). The Council must consider those guidelines when making decisions during the "merger proposal period", which commenced on 6 January 2016 and will conclude on the date on which a proclamation is made to amalgamate the Wyong and Gosford local government areas or the Minister for Local Government determines that he will not proceed with the proposal for that amalgamation: s.23A(3) of the LG Act. Councillors have been provided with a copy of those guidelines and have been given advice concerning those guidelines.

General Counsel can provide the Council with advice on the application of these guidelines to the proposed resolution to extend the TESP, as recommended by the EEDC.
