SUMMARY

Minutes of the Employment and Economic Development Committee held on 3 July 2013.

 - c. The dwellings within the medium density proposal shall be substantially completed (completion of foundations and floors) prior to the 14

December 2014 to be eligible for the Stimulus Plan rate.

- 7 That Council <u>develop</u> a strategy for infrastructure delivery that takes into account any loss of contributions for medium density proposals under the Stimulus Plan.
- That Council <u>approve</u>, subject to the agreement of all the current owners of 2-4 Holmes Avenue, Toukley, the surplus contributions monies paid in respect of that site be permitted to be transferred and used as a credit against contributions required to be paid in respect of another development in the area covered by the Toukley Contributions Plan.
