FRIENDLY EXCHANGE COOPERATION MEMORANDUM

BETWEEN

QINGPU DISTRICT OF SHANGHAI, CHINA

AND

WYONG SHIRE COUNCIL, AUSTRALIA

WHEREAS

Qingpu District of Shanghai, China and Wyong Shire Council of Australia share common geographic attributes and are both desirous of advancing the prosperity and enriching the culture of both their cities. The Cities intend to co-operate to their mutual advantage in trade, tourism and cultural development.

The cities wish to enhance mutual understanding and friendship between two cities and agree to establish friendly exchanges relations based on positive communications as follows:

- 2. Both cities may initiate various information sharing opportunities and exchanges in terms of the economy, trade, science and technology, culture, education, health, environmental protection, etc.
- 3. This memorandum is executed in English and Chinese. Both language versions are equally authentic. This memorandum is in duplicate, and each party has one copy.
- 4. This memorandum is signed and executed in Wyong Shire Council, Australia, and will be valid for three years from the date of enactment.
