Summary

It is necessary for the Council to adopt a resolution to formalise its intention to deal with certain matters in closed session. The reports are incorporated in the "Confidential" business paper which has been circulated.

The *Local Government Act 1993* requires the Acting Chief Executive Officer to identify those matters listed on the business paper which may be confidential in terms of s. 10A of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

Recommendation

- 1 That the Council <u>resolve</u> that the following matters be dealt with in closed session, pursuant to s. 10A(2)(c) and (a) of the Local Government Act 1993:
 - Report 5.1 Future Mode of Operation FMO 2.0 ERP Time and Attendance Project
 - Report 5.2 Approval to Acquire Strategically Important Land
 - Report 5.3 Mayoral (Administrator) Minute CEO
- That the Council <u>note</u> the reason for considering Report No 5.1 Future Mode of Operation FMO 2.0 ERP Time and Attendance Project and Report No 5.2 Approval to Acquire Strategically Important Land in closed session is that the reports contain:
 - 2(c) information that would, if disclosed, confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the Council is conducting (or proposes to conduct) business.
- 3 That the Council <u>note</u> the reason for considering Report No 5.3 Mayoral (Administrator) Minute CEO in closed session is that the report contains:
 - 2(a) personnel matters concerning particular individuals (other than Councillors)
- 4 That the Council <u>request</u> the Chief Executive Officer to report on these matters in open session of Council.

Note: Explanation - Section 10A of the Local Government Act 1993 states:

- "2(a) personnel matters concerning particular individuals (other than Councillors),
- 2(b) the personal hardship of any resident or ratepayer,
- 2(c) information that would, if disclosed, confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the Council is conducting (or proposes to conduct) business,
- 2(d) commercial information of a confidential nature that would, if disclosed:
 - (i) prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied it, or
 - (ii) confer a commercial advantage on a competitor of the Council, or
 - (iii) reveal a trade secret,
- 2(e) information that would, if disclosed, prejudice the maintenance of law,
- 2(f) matters affecting the security of the Council, Councillors, Council staff or Council property,
- 2(g) advice concerning litigation, or advice that would otherwise be privileged from production in legal proceedings on the ground of legal professional privilege,
- 2(h) information concerning the nature and location of a place or an item of Aboriginal significance on community land."
