I'm the editor of Playing in Puddles – a website that outlines the best of the Central Coast for kids, which gets 31,000 visits every month. I visit multiple parks each week and write reviews on them for the site so that parents and carers know what they'll find there before visiting.

We share these reviews with our readers (13,400 Facebook followers, 3,300 newsletter subscribers and 2,750 Instagram followers), and we know from the comments we get on our website and social media postings what the community wants. We know the community loved the changes made to the park at Macmasters Beach, but weren't so impressed by the new Lions Park at Gosford Waterfront. With all the feedback I get from readers I have a very good understanding of what the community's priorities are and I feel this knowledge could be very beneficial in helping Council make decisions on future play spaces that will be valued and well received by the community.

Readers like and share our posts, they tag their friends and they plan their park outings directly on our page in conversation with their friends. They tell us what aspects of the parks they like and what they don't like. They appeal to us to speak with Council to get their voices heard. As a member of the advisory committee we would be speaking on behalf of a very wide group in the community who have told us what facilities and equipment they're hoping to find at their recreational play spaces and local parks.


