## Item 7 Commitments made by State Government

Jay Spare and Jeanette Williams gave an update on recent grant submissions, successes and the Labor and Liberal Election funding commitments including \$4.3million from Liberal to construct vital roads and much needed footpaths in North Avoca and \$15million from Labor for Central Coast Shared Pathways to improve access for cyclists and pedestrians on the Tuggerawong Pathway, the Mannering Park Foreshore Route and the Avoca Kincumber Loop.

## Item 8 General Business and Close

a) Councillor Hogan and Councillor Gale Collins outlined the areas they would like feedback on as to how they've been addressed in the plans:

# <u>Clr Hogan</u>

- Kingfisher Shores the connection along Tall Timbers Road and Chain Valley Bay
- Mannering Park to Chain Valley Bay Foreshore Path
- Pacific Highway from Parktrees Village to Carters Road
- Budgewoi Public School access from Buff Point

## Clr Gale Collins

- Rawson Road Crossing Liberal commitment \$16.5M towards Rawson Road Crossing. Staff are
  working with Cardno and Sydney trains are also looking at how we can make the crossing safer
  for residents.
- Walkway around Empire Bay Drive (Nerang Road and Huntley Road)
- Funding around Terrigal Public School in regard to Pedestrian Access project currently under design regarding missing link around Hillcrest and Ena Street.
- Bellbird Road Terrigal
- Davistown Road, approaching Central Wharf area
- Umina Beach Public School Sydney/Melbourne Avenue, Rabaul Avenue safety concerns



- b) Helen Beazley raised the issue of people parking along bike lanes at the following areas:
  - East and West of Wells Street, Springfield
  - Wyong Road (North of Palmvalley Road, parallel to Hillside Drive)
  - Reliance Drive (southern intersection/Chittaway Bay end)
- c) Although not relevant to PAMP and Bike Plan, a comment was made about concern regarding mountain bike riding in natural areas. Noted that Council will soon have a survey available regarding this matter.
