#### 1 Introduction

Gary Chestnut was requested by the Committee to Chair the meeting. The Chairperson welcomed the Committee and completed an Acknowledgement of Country.

#### 2 Previous business

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#### 3 Brief progress reports on Umina Coastal Sandplain Woodland

Sharyn Styman (Environmental Management and Projects Officer) provided an update and presentation to the Committee on Umina Coastal Sandplain Woodland.

Key topics covered included:

- Progress Report on funding that was allocated to Council for Rehabilitation and Management of Umina Coastal Sandplain Woodland (UCSW). Report to March 2022 Council meeting.
- Progress report on Management actions:
  - o 3 priority sites
  - Question from Joy overgrown pathways
  - Offset with tracks specifically informal track closure
- Audit undertaken by Sharon Styman, Environmental Management and Projects Officer
  - Has since been a lot of growth and changes since November, some tracks have closed themselves with the growth.

Question from the Committee regarding Management Plan.

- Difference between Management Plan and Plan of Management was detailed and explained.
- o Plan for Umina Oval and UCSW, south of Umina Oval is covered.
- 3 year plan is in accordance with the Management Plans for Umina and Hillview St Reserve.
  - o Further detail provided regarding study undertaken in the 1990s.
  - o Frequent fires and arson events.
  - McDonald (author) identified a focus area of getting the balance regarding these fire events.
- Joy Cooper prefers yearly plans as opposed to 3 years plan.
- Gary Chestnut offered his view regarding 3 years providing more flexibility, having the 12-month period tried previously, this is a compromise.

#### 4 Brief progress reports on Scenic Road Bushland Reserve Offset Area

Sharyn Styman (Environmental Management and Projects Officer) provided an update and presentation to the Committee on Scenic Road Bushland Reserve Offset Area.

Key topics covered included:

- Weed control
- Feral animal control
- Public access, litter, domestic animals and edge effects
- Long-term fauna and vegetation monitoring
- Trust Funds The Scenic Road

Council staff then presented the 15 year plan, including the budgetary breakdown.

## Staff recommendation: That the Committee consider endorsing the 15 year plan Benefit

- Maximise time to complete works each financial year as funds available earlier
- Provide certainly in ongoing funding for actions that require longer-term planning, such as fire management.
