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sewage treatment system) and three instances of non-compliance with licence conditions reported in the 2020 annual return for Environment Protection Licence 2647 (Toukley sewage treatment system).

- Mangrove Creek Dam spillway rectification
- Mooney Dam water pump station
- Leak detection
- Drought response desalination readiness
- Recycled water review and refurbishment

In regard to the Mardi to Warnervale pipeline project and northern growth corridor, John Asquith enquired about any opportunities available for CEN to be included in the revegetation process and will have further discussions with Vanessa McCann on this matter.
