Hydrotherapy Pool Conditions of Entry

- Use of Hydro Pool is only available when swimming lessons or centre programs are not running, refer to timetable.
- No lap, casual or recreational swimming is permitted in the Hydrotherapy pool during 'hydro only' time. This time is a specialised centre for rehabilitation, supervised programs or therapeutic purpose pool for those with specific condition.
- Patrons with cuts, sores, open wounds, flu like symptoms, etc. should not enter the pool. As the only exception, approved waterproof dressings are allowable. For further guidance please report to staff.
- Acceptable swim attire must be worn by all patrons.
- You must shower before entering the pool.
- Patrons are required to use change room facilities to change into and out of swim wear.
- Incontinent adult or infant participants are required to wear protective swim pants.
- No food or drink (other than water from non-glass containers) is to be consumed in the pool.
- Other than for short term access requirements, please keep all doors and windows closed. Hydrotherapy is performed in a controlled environment and inappropriate use may alter the ambient temperature.
- Abusive, disruptive, offensive behaviour or language is not permitted. Offenders will be asked to leave.
- Toukley Aquatic Centre and Central Coast Council accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen belongings. Patrons are advised not to leave valuables in change rooms whilst in the pool.

Management reserves the right to refuse entry. Refusal to comply with these conditions of entry may result in removal from the facility.
